


Since 2013, **1,592** students have participated in the programme.



TAXES, FEES AND **OTHER PAYMENTS**



HAS BEEN PAID IN TAXES, FEES AND OTHER PAYMENTS.

Since 2010, Oyu Tolgoi has paid US\$4.2 billion** in taxes, fees and other payments, including the VAT* paid to Mongolian suppliers. In the first three quarter of 2023, Oyu Tolgoi paid US\$301 in the form of taxes, fees and other payments to the Government of Mongolia.

Oyu Tolgoi operations procurement team collaborated with 812 suppliers in the first three quarters of 2023, of which 704 are national businesses representing 88% of total operations procurement spend. Since 2010, Oyu Tolgoi has spent US\$10.8 billion on in-country procurement spend.

WATER USAGE PAYMENT

(2013 - Q3, 2023)



As of the third quarter of 2023, US\$62 million paid for water usage.



In the first three quarters of 2023, we exceeded our water recycling target of 80%, reaching 86.73%.



"100 MILLION TREE" PROGRAM PROGRESS

Established 2 tree nurseries in Khanbogd and Tsogt-Ovoo soum which has capacity of growing 250k and 500k saplings per year.

Reforestation of 20ha of degraded forest in Bogd Khan mountain.

Technical rehabilitation carried out on 400ha of disrupted, abandoned land caused by irresponsible mining in Yalbag valley of Selenge province.

Total of 55k tree saplings distrubuted among 2,600 employees.

30k trees planted on 35ha land in Khanbogd soum.

WATER USE EFFICIENCY


(CUBIC METRES PER TONNE OF ORE PROCESSED BY MONTHS)



Oyu Tolgoi used an average of 0.39 cubic metres of water per tonne of ore processed - significantly better than the global average of 1.2 cubic metres per tonne.

(PER CENT BY MONTH)




As of the third quarter of 2023, 68 percent of the total generated waste has been recycled.



PRODUCTION OF COPPER IN **CONCENTRATE**


(1,000 TONNES)

PRODUCTION OF GOLD IN **CONCENTRATE**


(1,000 OUNCES)
