

Since 2013, as of the first quarter of 2024, US\$66.7 million paid for water usage.



At the start of 2024, we exceeded our water recycling target of 80%, reaching 89.6%.



"100 MILLION TREE" **PROGRAM PROGRESS**

Established 2 tree nurseries in Khanbogd and Tsogt-Ovoo soum which has capacity of growing 250k and 500k saplings per year.

Enforcement fencing of 70ha and reforestation of 38ha of degraded forest in Bogd Khan mountain.


Technical rehabilitation carried out on 400.4ha of disrupted, abandoned land caused by irresponsible mining in Yalbag valley of Selenge province.

Total of 58,503 tree saplings distrubuted among 3,067 employees.

WATER USE EFFICIENCY


(CUBIC METRES PER TONNE OF ORE PROCESSED BY MONTHS)



Oyu Tolgoi used an average of 0.30 cubic metres of water per tonne of ore processed in the first quarter of 2024 which is four times lower than the global average of 1.2 cubic metres per tonne.

(PER CENT BY MONTH)




As of the first quarter of 2024, 61% of the total generated waste is recyclable waste.





PRODUCTION OF COPPER IN **CONCENTRATE**



PRODUCTION OF GOLD IN CONCENTRATE


(1,000 OUNCES)
